

TOWN OF AYNOR

Regular Council Meeting
February 19, 2019 6:30pm

Members present: Councilwoman Cheryl Skipper-Collins, Councilman Tony Godsey, Sr., Councilman Chris Shelley and Mayor John Gardner. Councilman Paul McCracken was unable to attend.

Mayor Gardner called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Councilwoman Skipper-Collins gave the invocation, and everyone said the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Gardner asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Councilman Shelley motioned to approve the agenda and Councilman Tony Godsey, Sr. seconded. Motion passed. Councilwoman Skipper-Collins then made a motion to approve the minutes from January 29, 2019. Councilman Godsey, Sr. gave second and motion passed.

There were no public comments.

In Discussion, Town Manager, Tony Godsey, Jr. discussed the results of the CTC meeting where he presented a request for the Phase IV Streetscape Project. The request was fully funded so he will continue coordinating with DOT on the project.

In Reports, the monthly financial reports were presented by the Town Clerk. Chief Thompson presented the PD report. The Mayor asked Chief Thompson if he had information on the Jordanville Hwy. bridge closure and the closures of Hwy. 319. Jordanville Hwy bridge was damaged from the past 2 hurricanes and needs to be re-engineered and could be closed up to a year. He spoke with DOT yesterday about 319 and they were working as quickly as possible to get it reopened. Councilman Godsey, Sr. thanked Councilman Shelley for his years of service as Mayor Pro Tem and congratulated Councilwoman Skipper-Collins on her nomination to Mayor Pro-Tem. Mayor Gardner reminded everyone their Statements of Economic Interest are due. He also spoke of the County reassessment meeting and commented that statements from Horry County should go out in July. Mayor also stated that the annual budgeting process will start in March. He suggested all Council members go ahead and be thinking of their budget priorities for the 2019-2020 fiscal year.

In Business, Mr. Shelley motioned to approve, as presented by Tony Godsey, Jr., Ordinance 19-01: Budget Amendment to Utilize Cemetery Fund – to fund the paving improvements to the Town Cemetery equaling \$31,200 plus contingency. Mr. Godsey, Sr. seconded motion and motion passed.

There was no need for executive session and no further business. Councilman Shelley motioned to adjourn, and Councilwoman Skipper-Collins seconded the motion. Motion passed, and meeting was adjourned.
